





## SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

## I. Nature

The Philippine Science High School Scholarship award is for the pursuance of a secondary course with special emphasis on the sciences and mathematics in preparation for science careers at the university level.

## II. Duration of Scholarship

The Scholarship shall be for a duration equivalent to the prescribed period of the secondary course, unless earlier terminated due to failure to comply with the terms of this scholarship agreement.

## III. Scholarship Privileges

The Party of second part shall be entitled to free tuition and free loan of available textbooks. He shall be entitled to the additional benefits that this scholarship category provides, subject to the availability of funds for the purpose and to pertinent accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

## IV. Responsibilities of the PSHS Scholar

## A. Academic Performance

The Party of the second Part shall have no failure in the subject using the qualitative ratings and shall maintain a yearly average of not lower than 2.5 and a cumulative average of not lower than 2.5 in the sciences and mathematics.

## B. Report Cards

The Party of the Second Part shall see to it that report cards are properly noted and signed by his/her parent/legal guardian.

## C. Conduct

The Party of the Second Part maintain proper conduct becoming of a scholar as defined by the Party of the First Part.

Unsatisfactory letter grades on behavioral reflected in the report cards of the Party of the Second Part shall, upon verification of their factual basis, constitute grounds for disciplinary action.

## D. Guidance and Supervision


The Party of the Second Part shall observe all rules and regulations prescribed by the school. He/She shall take all tests and inventories to establish data required for the effective school guidance and counselling program.

He shall be under the guidance and supervision of the Party of the First Part.

Consistent none compliance of the Party of the Second Part with the school rules and regulations shall be penalized with temporary withdrawal of Scholarship Privileges.

E. Report on Legal Guardian

The Party of the Second Part shall report any change of legal guardian or his representatives and their respective residential addresses.

V. Penalties

A. Termination of a Scholarship

This scholarship shall be terminated for failure of the Party of the Second Part to maintain the grade requirements or to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this agreement.

The termination shall be effective as of the date indicated in a written notice to that effect to the Party of the Second Part.

B. Suspension, Temporary Withdrawal of Privilege

The Party of the First Part shall impose appropriate sanction preliminary to termination, on a scholar for serious misbehavior such as destruction of school property, gambling, drinking, drug addiction, disrespect for authority, etc.

VI. Scholarship Obligations

A. Wilful Abandonment

The Party of the Second Part is required to complete the secondary course with emphasis on science and math at the PSHS-MC for wilful abandonment of the scholarship; he/she will be required to reimburse the money value (tuition and other registration fees based on the rates of U.P. Integrated School and living allowance) of his/her scholarship.

B. Pursue a Course in Science and Technology

After completion of his/her PSHS education, the Party of the Second Part must pursue an undergraduate degree program in science and Technology, specifically in the following fields of study:
